

END-USER LICENSE AGREEMENT FOR SOLO® MOBILE CLIENT

IMPORTANT PLEASE READ THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THIS LICENSE AGREEMENT CAREFULLY BEFORE PURCHASING, INSTALLING AND/OR USING THIS PROGRAM:

SoSoftware End-User License Agreement (“EULA”) is a legal agreement between you (either an individual or a single entity) and SoSoftware for the SoSoftware software product(s) identified above which may include associated software components, media, printed materials, and “online” or electronic documentation (“SOFTWARE PRODUCT”). By installing, copying, or otherwise using the SOFTWARE PRODUCT, you agree to be bound by the terms of this EULA. This license agreement represents the entire agreement concerning the program between you and SoSoftware, (referred to as “licenser”), and it supersedes any prior proposal, representation, or understanding between the parties. If you do not agree to the terms of this EULA, do not install or use the SOFTWARE PRODUCT.

The SOFTWARE PRODUCT is protected by copyright laws and international copyright treaties, as well as other intellectual property laws and treaties. The SOFTWARE PRODUCT is licensed, not sold.

1. GRANT OF LICENSE.

The SOFTWARE PRODUCT is licensed as follows:

- a) Installation and Use:
This One-Time Purchase subscription applies to only one (1) Device. During the first twelve (12) months of your subscription, if your original Device becomes non-operational you may be permitted, at SoSoftware’s sole discretion, to make a one-time transfer of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT Application to another supported mobile Device. To make a request for such transfer, please contact the SoSoftware Customer Service department via <http://www.sosoftware.com/support>. No transfers are permitted, for any reason, after twelve (12) months from the purchase of your subscription. Although software fixes, updates and patches are included in the One-Time Purchase, a free upgrade to the next version(s) of SOFTWARE PRODUCT is not.

2. DESCRIPTION OF OTHER RIGHTS AND LIMITATIONS.

- a) Maintenance of Copyright Notices.
You must not remove or alter any copyright notices on any and all copies of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT.
- b) Distribution.
You may not distribute registered copies of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT to third parties.
- c) Prohibition on Reverse Engineering, Decompilation, and Disassembly.
You may not reverse engineer, decompile, or disassemble the SOFTWARE PRODUCT, except and only to the extent that such activity is expressly permitted by applicable law notwithstanding this limitation.
- d) Rental.
You may not rent, lease, or lend the SOFTWARE PRODUCT.
- e) Support Services.
No support is provided
- f) Compliance with Applicable Laws.
You must comply with all applicable laws regarding use of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT.

3. TERMINATION

Without prejudice to any other rights, SoSoftware may terminate this EULA if you fail to comply with the terms and conditions of this EULA. In such event, you must destroy all copies of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT in your possession.

4. COPYRIGHT

All title, including but not limited to copyrights, in and to the SOFTWARE PRODUCT and any copies thereof are owned by SoSoftware or its suppliers. All title and intellectual property rights in and to the content which may be accessed through use of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT is the property of the respective content owner and may be protected by applicable copyright or other intellectual property laws and treaties. This EULA grants you no rights to use such content. All rights not expressly granted are reserved by SoSoftware.

5. NO WARRANTIES

SoSoftware expressly disclaims any warranty for the SOFTWARE PRODUCT. The SOFTWARE PRODUCT is provided 'As Is' without any express or implied warranty of any kind, including but not limited to any warranties of merchantability, no infringement, or fitness of a particular purpose. SoSoftware does not warrant or assume responsibility for the accuracy or completeness of any information, text, graphics, links or other items contained within the SOFTWARE PRODUCT. SoSoftware makes no warranties respecting any harm that may be caused by the transmission of a computer virus, worm, time bomb, logic bomb, or other such computer program. SoSoftware further expressly disclaims any warranty or representation to Authorized Users or to any third party.

6. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

In no event shall SoSoftware be liable for any damages (including, without limitation, lost profits, business interruption, or lost information) rising out of 'Authorized Users' use of or inability to use the SOFTWARE PRODUCT, even if SoSoftware has been advised of the possibility of such damages. In no event will SoSoftware be liable for loss of data or for indirect, special, incidental, consequential (including lost profit), or other damages based in contract, tort or otherwise. The United Nations Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods does not apply to this EULA.

This EULA and SoSoftware's Privacy Policy, which is incorporated herein by reference, constitute the entire agreement of you and any SoSoftware Party concerning your use of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT, its OUTPUT and the MEDIA, and supersedes all discussions, proposals, bids, invitations, orders, and other communications, oral or written, on this subject.

This EULA may not be waived, amended, or modified in any way except through a written agreement signed by SoSoftware. If any one or more provisions of this EULA are found to be illegal or unenforceable, the remaining provisions will be enforced to the maximum extent possible.
